

Procedures and Policies for Maintaining and Utilizing the Facilities of Institute

The facilities available in E-Learning Centre/Computer Lab and Studio:

RIE, Ajmer has a state of art Studio for development of E-Content/Audio/Video programmes. Studio has analog recording facility. The studio has got broadcast standard reverberation time and sound proofing. Audio/Video recording, editing and mixing are done on this console. Institute also has 100 MBPS NKN connections which makes internet access fast and convenient. Labs/premises of campus are Wi-Fi enabled and 05 Smart Class Rooms fully equipped with public address system, LCD projectors playback /recording facilities for audio/video at real time at the Institute. All national and international programmes, conferences, seminars, workshops and hand on sessions for teachers as well students are organized that enable them to update their knowledge and skills to become more logical, creative and updated in the field of technology.

The Institute library developed an e-library platform to provide access to the users to use its e-resources. Local Area Network (LAN) of the library got connected to the Institute network for wider dissemination of library services up to the level of hostels. For accessing library e-resources without cable connectivity Wi-Fi routers and access points were installed at various points of the library, Institute and hostels. E-resources like e-books, e-journals and databases from various vendors have been procured in the library.

Multipurpose Ground: Physical Education staff maintains playgrounds regularly. Physical Education Section has Roller, Lawn mowers, Grass cutting machines for maintaining the ground. Gymnasium: The servicing of all the gym equipments is done on regular basis. Regular oiling etc. work is done by the ground staff. Broken equipments are changed immediately.

Physical Verification: Physical verification of both consumable and non-consumable items is done annually by the committee constituted by the Committee.

Laboratories: There are well maintained and functional laboratories in the Departments of the Institute. In the Department of Education in Social Science and Humanities there is Geography & GIS lab and a Language lab. In the Department of Education there is a Psychology laboratory. In the Department of Education in Science and Mathematics there are labs each in Chemistry, Zoology, Botany, Physics, Mathematics, Radio & Electricity, Agriculture and Innovation hub. Physical verification of both consumable and non-consumable items of the Laboratories is done annually by the committee constituted by the Institute and through this exercise there is a provision for write off for the equipment which is no more in use. Institute has an Environmental Education Theme Park to promote environmental awareness through interactive way and to bring school children, youth and teachers to a forum where they can discuss their perspectives on the environmental issues. A wide array of Eco Smart programmes are designed to expand learning experience beyond the boundaries of the classroom in the natural environment of Aravali range providing opportunity for students, teachers and educators to enjoy natural beauty and outstanding 'living laboratory'.
