Prof. Ashish Bhatnagar, a member as nominee of Vice-Chancellor, MDS University, Ajmer could not attend the meeting.

The meeting commenced with a felicitation and welcome address by Prof. S.V. Sharma, Chairperson of IQAC followed by a brief introduction. He stipulated the objectives of meeting and expectations from the members.

Prof. B.K. Tripathi, a member as Nominee of Director, NCERT, New Delhi gave the inaugural remarks specifying the important recommendations of NEP 2020 in different domains of education. Prof. Tripathi focused on curriculum transaction leading to effective research and learning outcomes.

Prof. Anil Kumar made a presentation on "Evolving Graduate Attributes for Teacher education Programme in Present Context in the light of NEP 2020". He emphasised that NAAC should be viewed as an integral institution. Quality is a journey not a destination. Programme level outcomes or graduate attributes should be based on today's scenario. Experiential learning is of immense relevance in present time. The most important attributes required for learners are such as critical thinking, analytical thinking, lifelong learning, leadership skills, cultural intelligence, interpersonal communication skills etc. He also emphasised on reforms in examination system too. Finally, he recommended that institute must take utmost care while preparing and uploading the Self Study Report (SSR) on NAAC portal for reaccreditation.

Prof. Saryug Yadav, Prof. Pritish Acharya, Prof. H.C. Jain, Prof. C.K. Ghosh, Mr. Umesh Chaurasia, Mr. J.K. Sharma, Alumnus Dr. R.P. Sharma, Alumnus Mr. Ramniwas Galav and student representatives Jai Prakash (M.Ed. Second Year), Shivakant Gupta (B.Ed. Second Year), Harshita Udavat (B.A. B.Ed. Final Year) and Satyendra Nath Pandey (BSc. B.Ed. Final Year) along with other members of IQAC participated actively in the discussion and deliberations. After having discussion at the length, following suggestions/action points emerged:


- Value-based education.

- Focused efforts on creating research culture.


Prof. K.K. He also recommended following action points:




